

## Call for application

### THOHUN Scholarship 2020 for International One Health Conference

This year, the 6th World One Health Congress co-organized by the One Health Platform, the University of Edinburgh, Edinburgh Infectious Diseases, Africa CDC and the Southern African Centre for Infectious Disease Surveillance will be held in Edinburgh, Scotland, from 30 October to 3 November 2020. The conference is established as One Health Platform or OH scientific reference network aiming to enhance understanding of and preparedness for current and future outbreaks of zoonoses, emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases in humans and animals including antimicrobial resistance, ecological and environmental factors which drive and impact on these diseases. To expand THOHUN's partnership to a global scale and strengthen all capacity in One Health teaching, research and community outreach, THOHUN with the USAID One Health Workforce-Next Generation (OHW-NG) provides scholarship to all THOHUN's University members who has participated and abstract submitted for oral and/or poster presentation in this conference. The scholarship will provide international flight, accommodation, M&IE, registration fee (early bird fee), visa fee, insurance and ground transportation. Members who have submitted the abstract at the conference and wish to receive the grant could apply at THOHUN-NCO from now until August 21, 2020.

#### Scholarship information

- **One (1)** scholarship is available to attend international conferences related to One Health.
- The scholarship is limited to approximately **THB 125,000**. Types of expenses covered by the scholarships include:

- Other allowable costs related to the conference or event may be charged without exceeding the above-mentioned amount.

## Eligibility

- Personnel or students of THOHUN member universities.
- Candidates' participation at international conferences must be oral / poster presentation.
- Excellent command of the English language (valid TOEIC/TOEFL scores, letter of recommendation from adviser/supervisor, and/or interview by THOHUN reviewers)
- Candidates must present their accomplishments and experiences from attending the conference at Deans, Partners and Steering Committee Meeting.

## Application Dates

- Grant applications must be submitted to THOHUN NCO approximately **1 month prior to the conference.**
- Grant applications may be submitted from **Now to August 21, 2020.**
- The conference applied for must be completed by **September 18, 2020.**

## Required documents for application

- Acceptance letter from conference organizer
- Abstract of the paper/poster
- Conference agenda
- Budget details
- Registration documents, if any
- Other related documents, if any
- Required documents for application

## Required documents for completion of the scholarship

Recipients of the scholarship are required to submit (**within 7 days after end of the conference**) any of the following:

- Travel/Trip report
- Proof of attendance
- Copy of the abstract in abstract book of the conference
- Certificate of participation
- Participant evaluation scores (e.g. pre- and post-tests)

## Application review

The THOHUN Steering committee will evaluate all submitted applications. Potential applicants may be interviewed to evaluate English proficiency. Applicant will be duly notified as soon as a decision is reached.
