THOHUN Scholarship 2021 for International One Health Conference

To expand THOHUN's partnership to a global scale and strengthen all capacity in One Health teaching, research, and community outreach, THOHUN with the USAID One Health Workforce-Next Generation (OHW-NG) provide scholarship to all THOHUN's University members who have participated and abstracts submitted for oral and/or poster presentation in conferences. The activity goals to update knowledge, skills, tools, and technology required for virtual education and research that need during the ongoing pandemic of COVID-19, in which in-person activities are limited. This year, the number of scholarships is **six awards** to provide an opportunity for university members to present research and OH implementation output/outcomes and share their related works, experiences, and accomplishments in **“the Eighth International Meeting on Emerging Diseases and Surveillance, IMED 2021”**. We are not limited to the platform (in-person or virtual) of international academic conferences or workshops if you have academic researches related to One Health and meet the grant and conferences requirements. The scholarship will provide registration fee (early bird fee). Members who have submitted the abstract at the conference and wish to receive the grant could apply at THOHUN-NCO from now until June 30, 2021.

Scholarship information

- **Six (6)** scholarships are available to attend “the Eighth International Meeting on Emerging Diseases and Surveillance, IMED 2021”
- The scholarship is limited to **US \$150.00 (Attendee) or US \$85.00 (Student/Trainee/Nurse)**

Types of expenses covered by the scholarships include:

Registration fee	US \$150.00 (Attendee) or US \$85.00 (Student/Trainee/Nurse)

- Other allowable costs related to the conference or event may be charged without exceeding the above-mentioned amount.

Eligibility

- Personnel or students of THOHUN member universities.
- Candidates’ participation at international conferences must be oral / poster presentation.
- Excellent command of the English language (valid TOEIC/TOEFL scores, letter of recommendation from adviser/supervisor, and/or interview by THOHUN reviewers)
- Candidates must present their accomplishments and experiences from attending the conference in Deans, Partners and Steering Committee Meeting

Application Dates

- Grant applications must be submitted to THOHUN NCO by **June 30, 2021**.

Required documents for application

- Acceptance letter from conference organizer
- Abstract of the paper/poster
- Conference agenda
- Budget details
- Registration documents, if any
- Other related documents, if any
- Required documents for application

Required documents for completion of the scholarship

Recipients of the scholarship are required to submit (**within 7 days after end of the conference**) any of the following:

- Conference report
- Proof of attendance such as pictures and videos
- Copy of the abstract in abstract book of the conference
- Certificate of participation
- Participant evaluation scores (e.g. pre- and post-tests)

Application review

The THOHUN Steering committee will evaluate all submitted applications. Potential applicants may be interviewed to evaluate English proficiency. Applicant will be duly notified as soon as a decision is reached.
